Must write an essay on why community service is important and the community service you have completed.

Deadline: January

Eligibility: Must be a public or private school student in grades 4-11 in Delaware, Maryland or Washington, DC. Each school receives one application to nominate the "best and the brightest" student in the school who has at least a 3.75 GPA and strong community service. Must be a U.S. citizen.

Award: \$1,000 to be held in trust and paid to an accredited four-year institution. 600+ awards made annually.

Chrysler Technical Scholarship

Deadline: April 1

Eligibility: Must be a Delaware resident and not older than 23 years of age at the time of applying. Must have at least a 2.75 GPA and provide evidence of a commitment to leadership in the community. Must provide two reference letters that describe the applicant's leadership skills at school, in the community or with religious organizations. Must plan to obtain a degree or certificate from a community college, trade school or university in a technical field related to the design, engineering, manufacturing and repair of automotive products, including but not limited to, automotive repair, skilled trades or engineering.

Award: 20 one-year scholarships of \$1,000 assistance for worthy students based on demonstrated academic ability, leadership traits and financial need.

Award: One-year, one-time award of approximately \$1,000. Award is intended to supplement, not replace, other scholarships or funding. Funds may be used for payment of tuition or books.

Corporation Service Company (CSC) Student Opportunity Grant

Deadline: April 1

Eligibility: Must be a children of current, full time employees of CSC

Award: A one year, \$1,000 renewable scholarship, up to four years, to be paid directly to the institution that the student will attend in semi-annual payments of \$500. Award is intended to supplement, not replace, other scholarships or funding. Funds may be used for payment of tuition or books.

Deadline: April 1

Eligibility: Must be a high school senior from Cape Henlopen, Indian River or Sussex County VoTech School District who has some financial need and plans to attend a Delaware college or university. Preference will be given to students who will be attending Goldey-Beacom College or Delaware Technical & Community College (Owen Campus). Must submit completed application (available at high school), high school transcript, SAT scores, list of extracurricular activities and honors, and a copy of family's latest federal tax form.

Award: One-year, one-time award of approximately \$1,000. Award is intended to supplement, not replace, other scholarships or funding. Funds may be used for payment of tuition or books.

Delaware Youth Leadership Scholarship

Deadline: April 1

Eligibility: Must be a student leader in the Jefferson Awards YSI Program at his/her local high school or a Jefferson Awards recipient during his/her freshman, sophomore, junior, or senior year. Must be a college-bound high school senior at a Delaware high school and show exemplary attributes in scholarship, leadership, and service

Award: Three (3) \$1,000 scholarships; one each in Kent, New Castle and Sussex Counties

Eligibility: Must be a student who is an active member of LPGA Urban Youth Golf Program. LPGA Junior Advisory Board Award Scholarships are for college or higher education

Don and Nancy Edwards Scholarship

Deadline: October 31, 2010

Eligibility: Must be identified and recommended through the Upward Bound program at the University of Delaware or Delaware Technical & Community College. Must demonstrate academic ability and financial need and plan to pursue a four-year college degree.

Award: Up to \$5,000/year after other scholarships and funding are applied to the students account. Scholarship to be awarded every two years.

Helen L. & Douglas C. Eliason Scholarship Fund

Deadline: April 1

Eligibility: Low- to moderate-income working adults (Delaware residents only) who want to improve their employment potential through continuing education or technical training or high school low to moderate income students living in New Castle County.

Award: Varies; students may reapply for continued support. Award is intended to supplement, not replace, other scholarships or funding. May be used for payment of tuition or books.

Endo Pharmaceuticals Scholarship Fund

Deadline: April 1

Eligibility: Scholarship recipients shall be children of employees in good standing of Endo Pharmaceuticals; so long as the employee is at the senior director level or below at the time the scholarship is awarded. Students be under the age of 25 and must major in one of the following majors: Biology, biochemistry, physiology, bioengineering, biological process engineering, chemistry, chemical engineering, pharmacy, Physician Assistant program, nurse or nurse practitioner programs.

Award: Awards shall be based on a student's academic promise, high level of motivation and personal commitment to the life sciences. Award is intended to supplement, not replace, other scholarships or funding. May be used for payment of tuition or books.

Eligibility: Applicant must be a US citizen and a member or a child or grandchild of a member of the Friends of the Hockessin Library. Applicant must be accepted to or attending an accredited, post secondary educational institution. The applicant can be a full or part time student. Applicant must demonstrate excellent scholarship, leadership, community service and outstanding character. Preference given to Delaware and Southeastern Pennsylvania applicants; however, others may apply.

Award: The type and amount of aid shall be at the discretion of the Board of Directors of the Delaware Community Foundation and may include awards up to \$5,000 for full time students and up to \$3,000 for part time students.

Generation III Scholarship Fund

Deadline: Applications must be postmarked by April 23, 2010

Eligibility: Must be a Delaware resident who plans to attend one of the following institutions: University of Delaware, Delaware Technical & Community College, Goldey-Beacom College, Wesley College, Delaware State University or Lincoln University. Student must pursue an associate's or bachelor's degree in a business- or construction-related field. Applicant may not be an employee of the EDiS Company or a relative of an employee of the EDiS Company.

Award: \$1,000 renewable for up to four years with a cumulative 2.5 GPA or greater

Deadline: April 1

Eligibility: Must be a female graduating senior at Cape Henlopen High School and be enrolled or intend to enroll at an accredited college or university with an intended major in a business-related field.

Award: One-year, one-time award of \$1,000; manner and method for selecting recipients shall be the sole responsibility of the Scholarship Advisory Committee.

Hastings Memorial Scholarship

Deadline: April 1

Award: One (1) \$4,000 scholarship awarded once every four years and is payable in the amount of \$1,000 each year for four years upon evidence that the enrolled student is in good standing.

Deadline: Applications submitted to school guidance counselor by April 1

Award: One-year, one-time award of \$500 awarded annually in each of the Capital and Cape Henlopen School Districts.

Harold Holland Scholarship

Deadline: April 1

Eligibility: Student must be graduating from the eighth grade. Student's primary residence must be from within one of the following primary school districts—Delmar, Laurel, Seaford or Woodbridge and be recommended by a guidance counselor or teacher based on citizenship qualities, work ethic and service to the community. Must write an essay on why community service is important and the community service you have completed.

Award: One-time award; amount varies

Janosik Family Scholarship

Deadline: April 1

Eligibility: Applicants must be in grades 4 through 12, attend an Eastern Shore school, and be recommended by a guidance counselor or teacher based on citizenship qualities, work ethic and service to the community. Must write a 250-word essay on the lessons learned from reading *Back to the Basics* by Johnny Janosik or *Gifted Hands* by Dr. Ben Carson.

Award: Scholarship is awarded once the student is accepted at an accredited university. Students can apply over multiple years until they graduate from high school.

Deadline: April 1

Bob LaPrad Scholarship

Deadline: April 1

Eligibility: Student must be graduating from the 11th or 12th grade. Student's primary residence must be from within one of the following primary school districts—Delmar, Laurel, Seaford or Woodbridge and be recommended by a guidance counselor or teacher based on citizenship qualities, work ethic and service to the community. Must write an essay on why community service is important and the community service you have completed. Students planning a course of study in the field of engineering and students planning to attend a university in the State of Delaware will be given preference.

Award: One-time award; amount varies

Patrick Lynn Scholarship Fund

Deadline: April 1

Eligibility: Must be a senior attending Dover High School.

Award: \$1,000 award

Keisha M. Michael Memorial Scholarship

Deadline: April 10, 2010

Eligibility: Open to any African American senior residing in New Castle County who has a 2.5 GPA and will be attending a Historically Black College or University. A brief essay must be written on how a college education will help you make an impact upon the community and affect your life. Community and Church service are considered. Personal recommendation is required.

Award: Minimum \$1,000, depending on GPA and materials submitted. Awardees can reapply after the first year.

William J. & H. Virginia Miller Jr. Scholarship

Deadline: April 1

Eligibility: Must be a graduating senior from St. Thomas More Preparatory High School or Cab Calloway School of the Arts and be accepted into an accredited college or university with an intended major in a business-related field. Applicants must have a 2.75 GPA and provide evidence of leadership in the community as substantiated by reference letters. No preference will be given to applicants on the basis of race, religion or gender.

Award: Awards shall be made at such times and in such amounts as determined by the DCF Board of Directors. Award is intended to supplement, not replace, other scholarships or funding. Funds may be used for payment of tuition or books.

Governor Minner Biotech Scholarship

Deadline: April 1

Eligibility: Must be planning to obtain a degree or certificate in the biotech field from the University of Delaware, Delaware State University or Delaware Technical & Community College. Must demonstrate excellent grades in academic courses, including basic science courses and relevant specialized courses. Preference is given to students that are Delaware residents; however, students who are not Delaware residents may apply.

Award: Scholarships of up to \$3,500 each will be awarded to students attending each of the three eligible institutions. The type and amount of aid shall be at the discretion of the Board of Directors of the Delaware Community Foundation.

Geneva Pepper Morris Memorial Scholarship

Deadline: April 1

Eligibility: Must be a female graduating senior at Cape Henlopen High School and be enrolled or intend to enroll at an accredited college or university with an intended major in a business-related field.

Award: One-year, one-time award of \$1,000; manner and method for selecting recipients shall be the sole responsibility of the Scholarship Advisory Committee.

J.D. O'Connor Scholarship

Deadline: April 1

Eligibility: Restricted to graduating seniors from a Sussex County high school and attending an accredited Delaware institution.

Award: \$1,000/year (semi-annual payments of \$500). May reapply for future funding as long as a 2.5 GPA is maintained and subject to verification that the student is enrolled full-time and in good standing. May receive a total of four annual awards.

John M. Roca Memorial Scholarship

Deadline: April 1

Eligibility: Must be a senior at senior at Cape Henlopen High School accepted at a four-year college or university aspiring to an undergraduate degree in agricultural and natural resource management, pre-veterinary medicine, art or related fields. Must have a GPA of 3.5 or better. Factors to be considered include academic performance (GPA and class rank), high school activities, SAT scores, volunteer activities and teacher recommendation letters.

Award: \$1,250/year subject to verification that the student is enrolled full-time and in good standing. Award is intended to supplement, not replace, other scholarships or funding. Funds may be used for payment of tuition or books.

John J. Ryan Scholarship Fund

Deadline: April 1

Eligibility: Must be a senior at Caesar Rodney High School accepted at a college or university aspiring to a career in education or teaching. Must seek to improve the quality of life in our society through teaching ideals.

Award: \$1,000 one-time award to be paid in January after the successful completion of the student's first semester in college.

John A. & Marion B. Smitheman Fund

Deadline: April 1

Eligibility: Must be a Kent County public school senior planning to study engineering in a Delaware institution.

Award: \$8,000 to be paid in four equal installments of \$2,000 over a four-year period. Recipients will be reviewed annually and must maintain a 2.8 cumulative GPA. Transcripts should be sent to the Delaware Community Foundation by the school.

Margaret A. Stafford Nursing Scholarship

Deadline: April 1

Eligibility: Must be a resident of Delaware who have been accepted into an accredited college or university's nursing program. Must be initiating or furthering nursing training. It is not required that applicants attend a Delaware college or university. It is expected that all recipients will seek to improve the quality of healthcare in our society through nursing practices that ensure that patients are a priority.

Award: One-time scholarship. Amount to be awarded annually at the discretion of the Delaware Community Foundation and based on the current value of the scholarship fund.

Henry H. Stroud, M.D. Memorial Scholarship

Deadline: April 1

Eligibility: Must be a Delaware resident who has been accepted at an accredited school of medicine. Awards will be based on the applicant's demonstrated commitment to pursuing the highest standards of excellence, ethics and compassion in the medical profession as well as his/her academic promise and financial need. Special consideration will be given to applicants demonstrating an entrepreneurial and innovative approach to medicine. Eligibility will not be based on gender, race or ethnic background, national origin or sexual orientation. Applicants will be ranked by each scholarship committee member on the basis of financial need, demonstrated academic promise, recommendation by a teacher, guidance counselor, or other appropriate party and an essay. Award is intended to supplement and not replace other financial support. Recipients are eligible to re-apply in successive years for a maximum of four (4) annual awards. The same criteria will be used to determine renewal awards.
